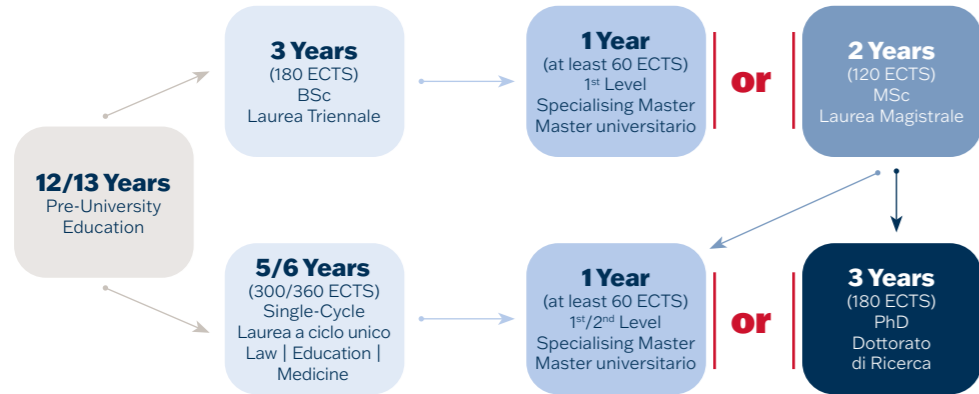

Tuition fees and scholarships

Tuition fees depend on fiscal residency, not on citizenship. The yearly tuition fee is divided in different instalments. The first instalment is paid upon admission: **€1,470** for **MSc programmes**, **€ 3,000** for **1-year Specialising Masters**.
