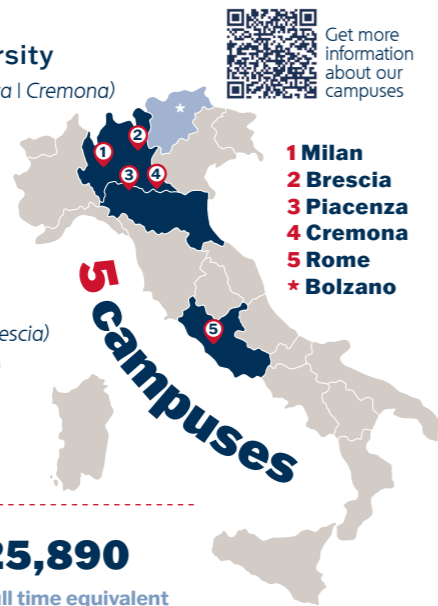

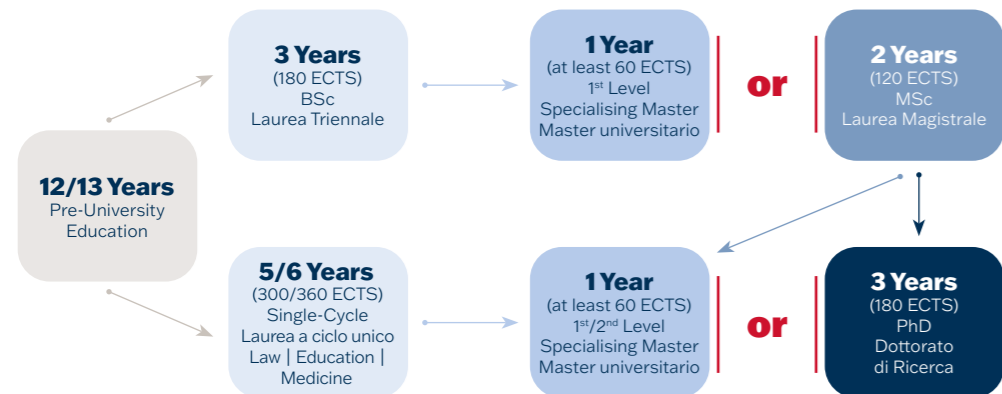

Admission requirements and procedures

General entry requirements:

- Minimum 12 years of previous global schooling
- Final 2 years in the same education system

Your **high school diploma** needs to satisfy the requirements in the awarding country to access university.

Examples of diploma-specific requirements:

- IB Diploma: full diploma, awarded by the session of May 2024
- American Diploma with additional 3 APs
- British Diploma: minimum 3 A-levels

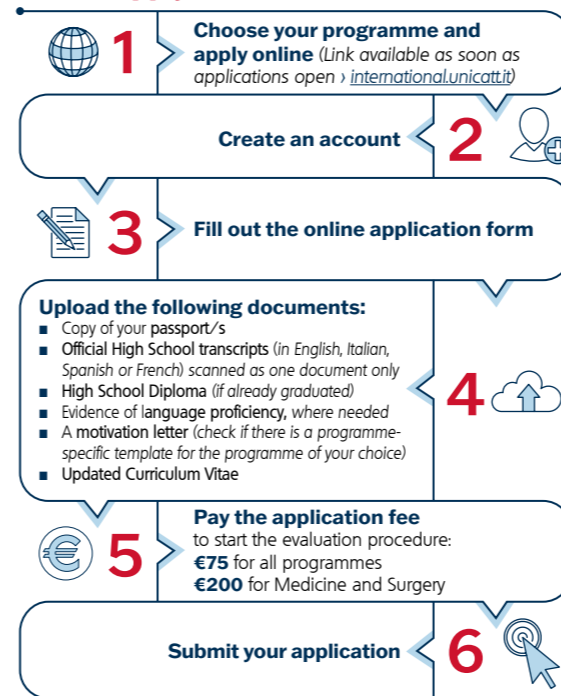

Tuition fees and scholarships*

Tuition fees depend on fiscal residency, not on citizenship.

The yearly tuition fee is divided in different instalments.

The first instalment is paid upon confirmation of admission: **€1,470** for **Undergraduate programmes**, **€4,000** for **Medicine and Surgery**.

The remaining instalments will be paid during the year of attendance.
