

Admission requirements and procedures

General entry requirements:

- Minimum 12 years of previous global schooling
- Final 2 years in the same education system

Your high school diploma needs to satisfy the requirements in the awarding country to access university.

Examples of diploma-specific requirements:

- IB Diploma: full IB Diploma by the May 2025 session (results available at the beginning of July 2025).
- American Diploma with additional 3 AP exams with the College Board
- British Diploma: minimum 3 A-levels

Language requirements

OR	 Complete a high school curriculum entirely taught in Italian OR Minimum B2 certified level of Italian (CILS, PLIDA or CELI)

Tuition fees and scholarships

Tuition fees depend on fiscal residency, not on citizenship. The yearly tuition fee is divided in different instalments.

The first instalment is paid upon confirmation of admission: €1,470 for BSc degrees, €4,000 for Medicine and Surgery. The remaining instalments will be paid during the year of attendance.
