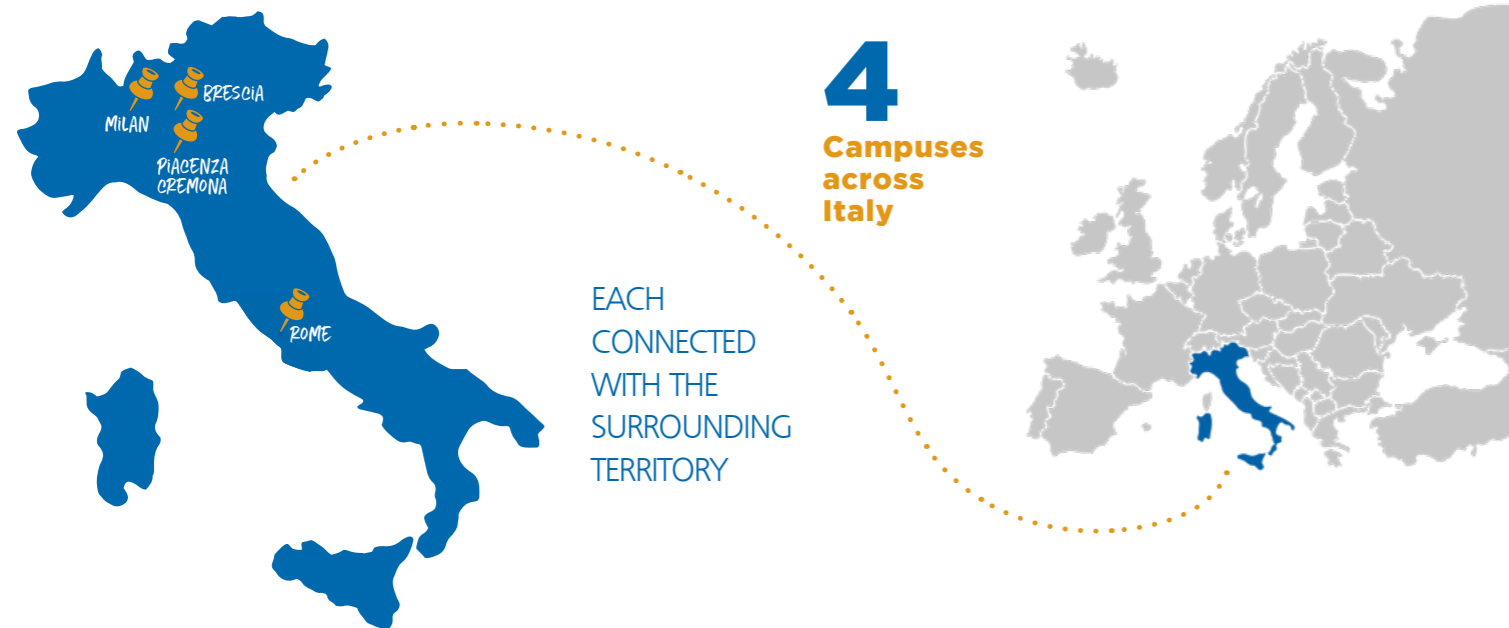

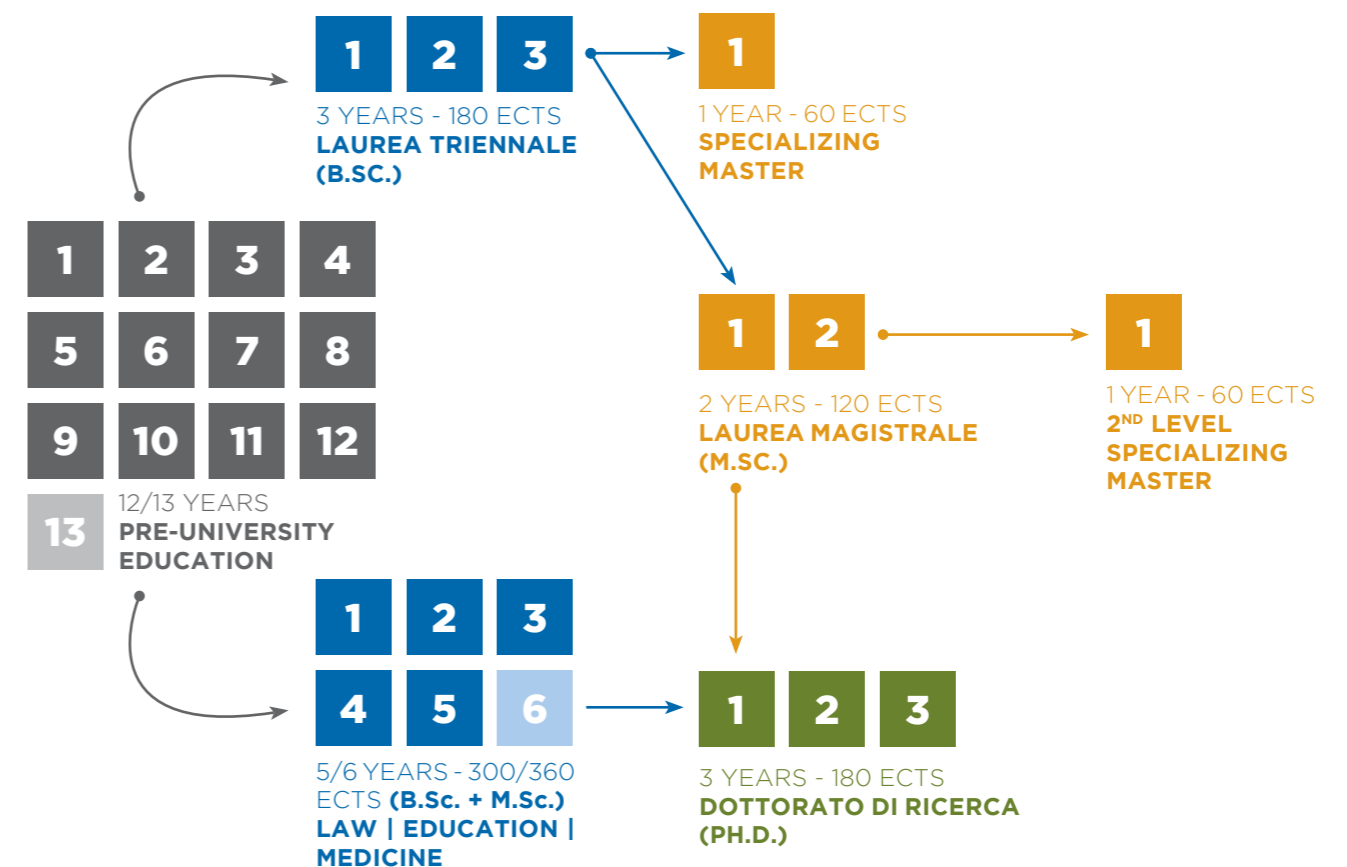

Admission Requirements & Procedures



- A high school qualification awarded after a minimum of 12 years of previous global schooling
- The high school qualification has to satisfy the requirements for access to university-level studies in the awarding country:
 - American and Canadian Diploma:** min. 3 APs in subjects relevant to the chosen program and SAT exam (min. 560 in both sections)
 - British Diploma:** min. 3 A-levels in subjects relevant to the chosen program
 - IB Diploma:** full diploma with at least one Math exam: Application and interpretation or Analysis and approaches (HL preferred in both cases)
 - National Diploma:** if admission to university-level studies is subject to a special exam in the country where you graduated from high school, you must give evidence to have passed such selection with the required scores



- Medicine and Surgery:** above requirements and passing Cattolica entrance exam, ranking within the first 50 (non-EU) or first 30 (EU) places according to your nationality
In the case of students with double nationality, if one is of an EU country, it will prevail for the purpose of the final ranking of the Competition Call. (art. 19, comma 2, of L. n. 218/1995).
In the case of students not confirming their offer and therefore making their seats available, we will move down the respective EU or NON-EU ranking.

Language requirements



English language proficiency (for English-taught programs - NO ITALIAN IS REQUIRED)

- Upper secondary studies completed fully in English, or in one of the listed national education systems, IB Diploma included (visit international.unicatt.it)
- Academic IELTS (min 6.0); TOEFL (IBT min. 80); FCE (min. B)



Italian language proficiency (ONLY for Italian-taught programs):

- If Italian is your mother tongue or if your high school is fully taught in Italian, no certificate is needed
- B2 (intermediate level), CILS or PLIDA, a language proficiency report by the attended language school



Mathematics requirements

For the B.Sc. in Economics and Management, and B.Sc. in International Relations and Global Affairs, applicants with high grades in Mathematics will be prioritized.
High SAT or ACT scores can also increase chances of admission.

- Copy of your passport*
- Official High School transcripts (accepted in English/Italian/Spanish/French).
Please scan these as one file document

- Evidence of language proficiency, where needed
- A motivation letter
- Updated CV

Tuition Fees & Scholarships



Tuition fees depend on where the family income is produced and taxed: not on your nationality.

Residency	Tuition fees*	Scholarship opportunities
EU income	Medicine and Surgery: tuition ranges between 7,000 € - 16,000 € per year. All other undergraduate programs: tuition ranges between 3,500 € - 8,700 € per year.	Scholarship opportunities provided by Educatt
Non-EU income	Medicine and Surgery: tuition is €15,800 per year. All other undergraduate programs: tuition is €8,040 per year.	Medicine and Surgery: Scholarship opportunities provided by Educatt All other programs: UCSC International scholarship. Merit-based, no extra application needed. The awarding is communicated with the admission to the program and it reduces the yearly tuition to € 5.000. It remains valid for all the 3 year duration of the program.
