

Admission requirements

General entry requirements:

- Minimum 12 years of previous global schooling
- Final 2 years in the same education system

Your high school diploma needs to satisfy the requirements in the awarding country to access university.

Examples of diploma-specific requirements:

- IB Diploma: full IB Diploma by the May 2025 session (results available at the beginning of July 2025).
- American Diploma with additional 3 AP exams with the College Board
- British Diploma: minimum 3 A-levels

English-language requirements:

Complete a high school curriculum entirely taught in English

OR

Minimum B2 certified level of English

Science Subjects: No specific science subjects or grades are required. To be prepared for the entrance exam, we advise you read the "List of topics to study for the scientific questions" document on the website.

How to apply

If you wish to apply to **both** Medicine and Surgery (Rome) and Medicine and Surgery (Bolzano) degree programmes, you have to **submit two separate applications and pay two application fees.**

Create an account

Fill out the online application form

Upload the following documents:

- Copy of your passport/s
- Official High School transcripts (in English or Italian) scanned as one document only
- High School Diploma (if already graduated)
- Evidence of language proficiency, where needed (if already available)

Pay the €200 application fee to start the evaluation procedure

Submit your application

After submission, Università Cattolica's International Admissions Team will evaluate eligibility to access the Entrance exam. Only candidates whose eligibility has been confirmed will be officially assigned to one of the applicant rankings (EU or non-EU).

Entrance exam

Admission to the Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery is subject to the applicant's performance and subsequent ranking in **Università Cattolica's very own entrance exam.**


Entrance exam content and preparation



Exam format: The Entrance Exam will be conducted remotely using a proctoring system, allowing candidates to take the exam from home.

<u>Please note</u>: This option is still pending confirmation for EU applicants seeking admission to the Medicine and Surgery degree programme in Bolzano, who might take the exam in person at designated test centres.

Programme class size



In the case of students with **double nationality**, if one is of an **EU country**, it **will prevail** for the purpose of the final ranking of the Competition Call (art. 19, comma 2, of L n. 218/1995).
