

# How the EU pool and the non-EU pool are distinguished

### **EU** candidates

## You belong to the EU pool if you fall under any of the following categories:

- You have a passport of one of the countries mentioned below\* and you live anywhere around the world; (eg. You have a Spanish passport, and you live in the Philippines)
- You don't have a passport of any of the countries mentioned below\* BUT you live in Italy and have a valid Residency Permit/Permesso di Soggiorno; (eg. You have a Colombian passport, and you live in Italy with a valid residence permit) PLEASE NOTE: if you are in the process of requesting a Residency Permit for Italy (first issuance and/or renewal) make sure you declare it while filling in the application form.
- You have more than one passport, for example a non-EU passport AND an EU passport and you live anywhere in the world. The EU passport always takes priority. (eg. You have a Brazilian and a Portuguese passport, you live in Brazil)

### **NON-EU** candidates

#### You belong to the NON-EU pool if you fall under the following category:

- You don't have a passport of any of the countries mentioned below\* and you live anywhere in the world (excluding Italy). (e.g. You have a UK passport, and you live in the UK.) (e.g. You have a Korean passport and you live in Korea.) (e.g. You have a US passport, and you live in France.) (e.g. You have an Indian passport, and you live in the UAE.)
- You don't have a passport of any of the countries mentioned below and you live in Europe holding a • valid Residency Permit for the European country you live in (e.g. you hold a Korean Passport, you live in Portugal with a valid Residency Permit for Portugal). Only a Residency Permit for Italy replaces a candidate in the EU pool.
