

IB DIPLOMA UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION POLICY

If you have obtained or are going to acquire a **full IB Diploma** after a minimum of **12 years of education**, you can apply to one of our Bachelor programmes. Partial IB "Certificates" are NOT accepted.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

A minimum of 31 points obtained at the end of year 1 of your Diploma Program (DP) is recommended to increase your chances to access most of our bachelor programmes. Extra/bonus points and predicted grades are not considered.

Bachelor in Economics and Management only:

- Math Al/AA SL minimum grade of 5.
- Math AI/AA HL minimum grade of 4.

If you have lower grades, or wish to increase your chances of admission into the programme, you can submit the scores of the SAT or ACT test (see <u>Mathematics Requirements</u>).

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT:

If the IB Diploma is taught entirely in English, no other language certificate is required.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- complete high school transcript of DP end-of-year 1;
- if available, your latest transcript of DP year 2.
- (optional) predicted grades.
- If you have already graduated: final transcripts of both DP year 1 and 2, plus a copy of your final IB Diploma with scores.

AFTER RECEIVING AN OFFER AND CONFIRMING YOUR PLACE:

Before the release of the IB exam results, you must request that the IBO sends your final scores directly to Università Cattolica – our code is 001623. Instructions here.

This procedure replaces any other paperwork, such as the legalization and/or Dichiarazione di Valore.

To enroll, you must receive the **full IB Diploma by the May 2024 session** (results available at the beginning of July 2024). Retakes in November 2024 and/or IB Certificates will not be accepted. Università Cattolica does not make conditional offers based on a specific IB Diploma final score.
