

Students who apply to 2-year graduate degrees taught in English satisfy the language requirement if they hold one of the following certificates, issued starting from **January 1, 2018**:

The following 2-year graduate degrees require higher scores for some certificates:

IMPORTANT: Candidates must provide their English language certificate at the time of application. However, if the test has not been taken yet, candidates must provide the scheduled test date and **send the results no later than July 1, 2020.**

EXEMPTIONS BASED ON PRIOR STUDY

The following applicants are not required to undertake English language tests.

- Applicants who completed their university studies from one of the following national education systems:** Australia, Canada (with the exception of Quebec), Ireland, Malta, New Zealand, South Africa, United Kingdom, United States of America.
- Applicants who completed a degree program entirely taught in the English language:** they will need to **upload** to the online application **an official statement from their University indicating that English is the language of instruction.** However, **some Italian Representations** (e.g. in Iran, Bangladesh, Pakistan) **may require a language proficiency certificate.** You will need to meet the Consulate/Embassy's requirement to obtain your student visa.
