However, if you are staying with us for only one semester and would like to attend part of a full-year course, you may discuss this with the relevant professor and take a partial exam, thereby earning a reduced number of ECTS credits.

With the approval of the relevant professor, incoming students may choose to attend only one part of the selected full-year course and take a partial exam, thereby earning fewer ECTS credits than those indicated in the table.

2. INTERNATIONAL CURRICULUM

Erasmus+ students may take only one course from the International Curriculum. Registration for the selected course is required before arrival. Interested students are invited to follow the instructions that will be sent by email once the course registration process opens.

- Manfred Lachs Space Law Moot Court Competition**
 5 ECTS / October > April
 International students who will be staying for the full academic year may join the team representing Università Cattolica at the Manfred Lachs Space Law Moot Court Competition, a prestigious international moot court. Team members will take part in a simulated trial before an international tribunal and engage with complex issues of space law.

Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition, the world's largest moot court competition. Team members will prepare written and oral pleadings in a simulated dispute between States before the International Court of Justice, addressing timely questions of public international law.
