Course features

- Classes will be offered in-person (live-streaming is guaranteed in case of quarantine or sickness)

- Readings, exercises and short essay can be assigned during the semester

Academic Policies

- Attendance is mandatory for all classes and you are required to attend classes in-person (unless in quarantine); students must inform professors in advance if they are in the condition of not being able to attend in-person classes.
- Microphone and camera must be activated during live-streamed classes
- Internet connection must support live-streamed classes
 We advise you to use a pc or laptop and not a mobile (smartphone/tablet)
- Unexcused absences during in person classes and/or live-streamed classes, attendance without activating microphone and video or a frequent failure of the Internet connection will have a negative impact on your grade
- Exams cannot be rescheduled, or deadline postponed

Add/Drop weeks

- Where can you find the forms?
 - On the dedicated page: UCSC International Curriculum Spring 2022 (Box ADD DROP). A reminder with the procedure has been sent you;
 - Under the Box ADD DROP you will find the link to reserve an appointment, the ADD form and the DROP form.

If you need to ADD classes you MUST reserve an **online appointment** via TEAMS with me in order to see if the class you would like to add has a free spot; the reservation link will be active from <u>Wednesday 16 February at 2.30pm</u> until Sunday 20 February at 11.59pm. The reservation is managed **on a first-come first-served basis**; I will contact you then via TEAMS on the day and time you selected.

 Waiting List for <u>FULL classes</u> will be created according to online appointments starting from Monday 21 February.





Suggestions for Add/Drop



- If you did not select any class by the deadline you have to submit the <u>add form</u> and <u>reserve an online appointment</u> to check if you can add classes (adding is possible ONLY if there are still spots available)
- Add and drop classes only after speaking with your home advisor; your university has to agree with your exchange semester course choice
- Please go to the classes you selected, you have also the second week to modify your schedule



Withdrawal




- You can withdraw from classes **by April 27**
- You will receive an email that directs you to the dedicated page where you can find the Withdrawal form; you must complete that form in order to modify your schedule
- A W will be reported on your final transcript of records and no credits will be assigned; the W means that you left the class along the semester



Where can you view the room number?

- Go to your <u>iCatt page</u>
- Click on the tab named Courses
 - 1 Click on the arrow close to the title of the course

 - ✓ 3 Click on the star Add to favourites; this will facilitate the view of the course on the APP





Notes on classroom & buildings

Make sure to check **the letter** reported before the room number! It indicates the building where the class is located.

The first number indicates the floor.

Notes on classroom & buildings


Classroom numbers can change: check the section ROOM CHANGES on ICatt; in case it is a last-minute change, guardians update the board at the main entrance of the buildings.



Where can you activate Blackboard?

In order to access material and live streamed class, you have to activate blackboard for each class

- Go to your <u>iCatt page</u>
 - 1 Click on the tab named Courses
 - 2 Click on the black button
 - ✓ 3 Click on select
- Do these actions for all the international curriculum classes
- You might have several blue buttons (Select) for one class, one for each professor teaching the course, just click one button and all professors will be automatically selected

How can you access the single course?

- Click on the title of the course
- On the left side of the course page you can find the following menu (some sections might not be activated yet):
 - Announcements: check every day this section! it will be updated with professors' requests/announcements
 - ✓ Syllabus: it contains the course syllabus that is the agreement between you and the professor of the course
 - ✓ Instructor: Professors might report information on themselves
 - ✓ **Course Materials**: it contains slides and/or readings uploaded by professors;
 - ✓ Online Lecture: you access to the live streamed class through Blackboard Collaborate Ultra
 - ✓ Assessment: professors upload/manage midterm and final exams
 - ✓ **Panopto Video:** class recordings will be automatically sent into this section
 - E-mail: you can get in contact directly with your professors or classmates;
 - ✓ Forum: this section might be used to share information within the entire class
 - ✓ **My Grades**: you may view your personal grades if submitted by the professors.
 - UCSC Course Evaluation: this section contains an anonymous survey on the course you will be requested to fill in at the end of the semester

- Blackboard Collaborate Ultra is the tool used to deliver classes in dual mode

- We reccomend the latest versions of Chrome or Firefox





Confirm your attendance on campus

All students are expected to attend in person unless they are in quarantine. However, you are required to confirm your attendance.

You can confirm your attendance using the **ICatt APP**

- Click on Manage attendace
- Select the days circled in green and click yes to confirm
- The University uses this app to monitor the number of students on campus and in buildings



How grades are assigned

- Partial and final grades are available on **Blackboard**. Professors then publish the **final course grade** on your ICatt page at teh end of the semester.
- Grades will be assigned according to the Italian grading system (30/30). A grade below 18/30 is insufficient and will be marked as F (this is only valid for international curriculum courses)
