Tuition fees and scholarships

Tuition fees for MSc degrees depend on fiscal residency, not on citizenship. The yearly tuition fee is divided in different instalments. The first instalment is paid upon admission: €1,470 for MSc degrees, € 3,000 for 1-year Specialising Masters.
