## What is CAP?

*CAP* stands for Centro per l'Autoapprendimento: it is the self-access centre for languages of the **SeLdA** (Servizio Linguistico d'Ateneo) of our University.

# What does CAP offer?

The CAP offers a wide range of practice exercises and tools supporting and integrating topics covered during classes, as well as a language advisory service.

#### What does CAP aim at?

The CAP can help students to become autonomous and responsible language learners, that is: being able to define their own learning path according to individual needs, to select study material, and to learn how to self-evaluate their progress.

# Who are the language advisors?

The language advisors at the *CAP* help students in the definition of their personalised study programme and method.

#### How to access the CAP?

The entrance is **free** and there is **no need of reservation**. Students have to show their university ID (Carta Ateneo+). If looking for language advice, students should refer to the language advisors schedule.
